As a rural electricity user, my current delivery charges make up half, if not more of my current Ontario Hydro Bill each month. This is due to the fact that as a household, we have committed ourselves to being energy conscious and reducing our daytime and overall hydro use. Each month as I read our bill, I feel as though we are being punished for living in a rural area and saving electricity. It does not matter how much electricity we save or even if we have no power for a whole week, our delivery charge is still incredibly high.
