**Re: EnWin Utilities Ltd. – Application for Recovery of Stranded Meter Costs
(EB-2017-0132) – Request for Extension for Filing Interrogatory Responses**

We are counsel to EnWin Utilities Ltd. (“EnWin”) in connection with the above-referenced proceeding. EnWin received interrogatories from OEB Staff on July 4, 2017. There are no other intervenors in the proceeding. In accordance with Procedural Order No. 1, EnWin’s responses to staff’s interrogatories are due by July 25, 2017. Although EnWin has been working diligently to complete its responses, it will not be in a position to file them by such date. The main factor causing the delay is the need to provide historical information over a period during which EnWin initially was following Canadian GAAP and then transitioned to IFRS. EnWin’s metering information was organized differently under each of these regimes and, as a result, needs to be reconciled to be meaningful for the Board. EnWin has determined that it will require an additional 2 weeks to complete this task and therefore requests an extension to August 8, 2017 for filing its interrogatory responses.
