I am writing with respect to: EB-2017-0049.

I own two properties in the City of Kawartha Lakes, a home and a farm.

I am appalled at the "delivery charges" for the cost of hydro to my home.

In addition, even though I have not drawn power in over 5 years at the farm, I am paying a "delivery charge". I would understand from this application, that you plan to increase costs to both the farm (even though no power is being consumed) and the house, which is unacceptably high. When I add all the costs (delivery, regulatory, HST and "provincial rebate"), I find that the actual cost/kilowatt hour is almost double the stated value for peak, mid-peak and off-peak rates. Please take the necessary steps to reduce your cost base and bring our rates to a more acceptable level.
