What is the justification for this increase? Ontarians already pays more than persons in every province in Canada for electricity. Why must our cost be almost double that of Quebec? Why is the cost of delivery already as high as the cost of our electricity? Adding \$11.75 per month (based on 750kWh) is already a ridiculous amount for an already astronomical cost for "delivery". What is the breakdown of these "delivery" charges? Remember that these proposed numbers reflect a piggy backed increase on an already over charging system. It is completely unbelievable and audacious to be making this request when the provincial government is realizing the ballooning electricity costs in this province and making the appropriate cuts.
