## **LETTER OF DIRECTION**

Dear Ms.Chiasson:

Re: Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. Fenelon Falls Pipeline Project Board File Number EB-2017-0147

On July 26, 2017 Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under s. 90(1) and s. 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for Fenelon Falls Pipeline Project in the City of Kawartha Lakes and the Township of Brock in the Regional Municipality of Durham (Fenelon Falls Project). Enbridge also applied for certificate of public convenience and necessity for the City of Kawartha Lakes under s. 8 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*.

The OEB has issued a Notice of Hearing for Enbridge Gas's application (Notice). The Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 2 and 3 below **prior to August 24, 2017**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at Registrar@oeb.ca.

## You are directed:

1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.

- 2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Enbridge Gas' website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of the enclosed Notice, in the exact form accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:
  - a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
  - b. the clerk of the City of Kawartha Lakes and the Township of Brock in the Regional Municipality of Durham
  - all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
  - d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 222, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
  - e. all affected utilities and railway companies
  - f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- 3. To make a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge Gas' office and in a prominent place on Enbridge Gas' website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, immediately thereafter.
- 5. To provide a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
