my bill is already \$102 in delivery charges for a total bill of \$310. And this is a summer bill. You expect me to pay an extra \$2.79 per 750kw in Jan 2018. I heat electric. In the winter, I easily use 4000kw/month, so that would be an increase of at least \$15/month. Now if you think I will be able to afford the extra when my bills are already over \$700/month in the winter, I don't know where your mind is at. That is for running only 4 baseboard heaters, and basement was not heated because of cost. I hope the planet keeps warming, so I can afford to pay for heat in the winter. When one has to shut off main power to be able to lower kw, something is very wrong.
