As a residential customer with home heating on hydro, there has never been any discounts for being energy-wise or using a utility that is supposed "green". We added extra insulation, energy-stripping, new windows, energy-saving appliances, LED lighting and conserve whenever possible. Our monthly hydro bill almost as much as our mortgage payments while people heating on oil and gas were getting discounts for keeping their usage under a certain level while leaving lights on all night.

We need to be stop increasing rates and compounding the high cost of living in southern Ontario. Hard working people do not receive get the equivalent in salary increases to cover all of the rising costs, electricity included, and as a result, get poorer.
