Hydro One's application to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for a distribution rate increase requests a distribution rate increase and to apply the service charges on disconnection/reconnections, removal of load limiters, account collections and access to their poles all increased.

These increases would be added to utility bills before any rebates from the Fair Hydro Act, 2017 are implemented.

Premier Wynne promised electricity rate relief with her government's Fair Hydro Act. What the Premier didn't make clear was that Hydro One would still be able to apply for rate increases despite this new law, effectively negating part of the reduction.

I am completely against the granting of these increases that this government's energy policies would continue to add burden to our already expensive electricity system. Our energy costs are unrecognizable to those of just a few years ago.

So much for electricity rate relief!
