Based on the chart listed the amounts shown reflect what a monthly increase would look like (on average) with the increases being requested of the Ontario Energy Board.

2018 an increase of \$2.79 per month = \$33.48  
2019 an increase of \$2.47 per month = \$29.64  
2020 an increase of \$2.31 per month = \$27.72  
2021 an increase of \$1.95 per month = \$23.40  
2022 an increase of \$2.23 per month = \$26.76

Currently our monthly Hydro One bill is approximately \$250 + a reduction of 25% (or \$62.50) as per the Fair Hydro Act, 2017 = \$187.50.

This means (and is based on whether or not we are a typical customer using only 750Kwh/month) our bill will be as follows:

2018 an increase of \$2.79 per month = \$33.48 + 187.50-- NOW = \$220.98  
2019 an increase of \$2.47 per month = \$29.64 + 187.50-- NOW = \$217.14  
2020 an increase of \$2.31 per month = \$27.72 + 187.50-- NOW = \$215.22  
2021 an increase of \$1.95 per month = \$23.40 + 187.50-- NOW = \$210.90  
2022 an increase of \$2.23 per month = \$26.76 + 187.50-- NOW = \$214.26

Not to mention additional fees for late payments (which I will undoubtedly make due to the high cost of Hydro).  
So our bill for a small home of less than 1500 Ft/sq will cost MORE than what I am currently paying today.

Hydro One Networks Inc. needs to stop requesting increases from the Ontario Energy Board when they know full well customers can't afford the increase.

Is Hydro One not aware of the Fair Hydro Act of 2017? Did they miss that memo?

People who work hard, who are aging, who are sick and who have kids to raise CANNOT pay these fees any longer.

If the sale of Hydro One goes completely through there will eventually be NO MORE customers to gouge.

Stop the sale of Hydro One and STOP RAISING OUR RATES !!!
