Energy Storage Canada, Lisa DeMarco and other email recipients: I believe it is appropriate to recognize that the cost of energy transmission to energy storage Canada and the transmission back to the grid will be factors in determining the viability of energy storage. If the costs are competitive it will make more sense to build storage rather than larger generating stations. Energy storage may also assist in load shifting by storing energy during times of low cost electrical energy and releasing the energy back to the grid when the cost of energy is high.

I do hope OEB will see that Hydro One rates would have an effect on the economic viability of energy storage and consider offering ESC access to cost .
