Shell Canada Products (Shell) filed an application on July 27, 2017, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, for an electricity wholesaler licence.

As Shell has been operating without a licence, in contravention of section 57 of the OEB Act, it may be subject to an OEB compliance proceeding.
