Canadian Solar O and M (Ontario) Inc. (the “**Applicant**”) is hereby applying, pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, for an electricity generation license as the new operator of three ground-mount solar facilities known as Liskeard 1, Liskeard 3 and Liskeard 4 (the “**Facilities**”) under the Feed-in-Tariff contracts (the “**FIT Contracts**”) as described in the attached application.

The Facilities comprise part of a portfolio of eight ground-mount solar facilities owned by TransCanada Energy Ltd. (“**TCE**”), the current licensed owner and operator of the Facilities as well as other electricity generating facilities under Electricity Generation License No. EG-2009-0024 (the “**TCE License**”). Axiom Infinity Solar LP (“**Axiom**”) intends to acquire the Facilities from TCE pursuant to an asset purchase agreement executed by the parties. The transaction is scheduled to close in the coming days.

In connection with the impending acquisition outlined above, TCE and Axiom submitted concurrent letters to the OEB on October 25, 2017, requesting that the owner and operator roles for the Facilities be transferred from the TCE License to the new Axiom license. Upon subsequent review, it was determined that Axiom would not be in a position to take over the operator role for the Facilities as of the closing date of the transaction, and a transitional plan was devised wherein TCE will continue to be the operator of the Facilities until such time that Axiom is in a position to take on this role. As a result, TCE and Axiom concurrently sent a second letter to the OEB on November 20, 2017, requesting that the Board: 1) issue a generator license to Axiom as owner only for the Facilities as of the closing date of the transaction; and 2) amend the TCE License to maintain TCE as the operator of the Facilities as of the closing date of the transaction.

On November 30, 2017, the Board issued an Order conditionally granting Electricity Generation License No. EB-2017-0330 to Axiom and amending the TCE License in accordance with the requested manner as per the November 20, 2017 letter to the Board.

The Applicant is taking the necessary steps to assume the operator role for the Facilities from TCE on behalf of Axiom. The Applicant expects that it will be in a position to assume the operator role for the

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Facilities around mid-January 2018, though the exact date will not be known until a later time. The Applicant respectfully requests that the Board bring the Applicant's license application process to a final state such that the license can be immediately completed once the Board receives notice of the exact date that the Applicant will assume the operator role.

Enclosed are two copies of a completed and signed application form and attachments, together with a cheque payable to the Ontario Energy Board in the amount of \$1,000 for the application fee. Please note that the application includes Notices to Proceed and COD confirmation letter from the IESO.
