Re: EB-2017-0306 – Application by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. and Union Gas Limited for Approval to Amalgamate effective January 1, 2019

I am a consultant to the Consumers Council of Canada (“Council”). I have been instructed by my client to intervene in the Ontario Energy Board’s (“OEB” or “Board”) proceeding to consider the Application by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. and Union Gas Limited for approval to amalgamate to form a single natural gas distribution, transportation and storage company effective January 1, 2019. The Council is a public-interest entity which represents the interests of residential consumers in Ontario. The Board’s Decision arising from this proceeding will ultimately impact the rates that residential consumers pay for the delivery of natural gas.

On November 8, 2017, the Council filed with the Board, pursuant to Rule 22.03 of the Ontario Energy Board’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, a document describing the Council, its mandate and objectives, membership, the constituency represented, and the types of activities the Council carries out. In addition, we provided a list of the individuals authorized to represent the Council in Board proceedings.

The nature and scope of the Council’s intended participation in this proceeding will be the following:

1. To test the Applicants’ evidence and assess the reasonableness of the proposals set out in the Application;
2. To determine whether the proposals are in the best interests of the Applicants’ residential customers; and
3. To participate in various stages of the proceeding which may include an interrogatory process, a technical conference, a settlement conference and an oral hearing.

The Council intends to ask for an order of costs related to its participation in this proceeding. The Council has participated in many of the OEB’s natural gas proceedings over a long period of time. In all of its interventions before the OEB the Council has been recognized as being eligible for an award of costs. In the absence of an award of costs the Council would be unable to participate in this proceeding.
