Re: EB-2017-0255 – Union Gas Limited – 2018 Cap-and-Trade Compliance Plan – Extension Request

Pursuant to the letter issued by the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") to Union Gas Limited ("Union") on December 14, 2017 and subsequent discussions with OEB Staff on December 19, 2017 (the "Letter") Union is requesting an extension of time to file an update to its 2018 Cap-and-Trade Compliance Plan Application until January 8, 2018.

In its Letter, OEB Staff stated that in its view certain portions of the Strictly Confidential version of the Application are not clearly prohibited disclosures and should be reconsidered by Union for inclusion in the public version of its Application. As per the request of OEB Staff, Union will file an update to the redactions in its Application with the OEB and on the OEB's RESS by January 8, 2018. This extension will afford Union time to adequately consider and reflect the recommendations submitted by OEB Staff.
