IN THE MATTER OF the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B; and in particular sections 90 and 40(1) thereof.

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Union Gas Limited to the Ministry of Natural Resources for licences to drill wells in the Bickford Storage Pool;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Union Gas Limited for leave to construct a natural gas pipeline and ancillary facilities in the Township of St. Clair in the County of Lambton.

AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE

MAKE OATH AND SAY:

That I am an employee in the Registered Office of Union Gas Limited and, as such, have knowledge of the matters herein deposed to.

 - e. all affected utilities and railway companies

- f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- g. the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry, Petroleum Operations Section, London Ontario

- 3. On January 10, 2018, I did cause to make a copy of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Union's office and in a prominent place on Union's website.

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE

Union Gas Limited has applied for an approval to drill three natural gas wells and to construct a natural gas pipeline in the Township of St. Clair in Lambton County. Exhibit A Learn more. Have your say.

Union Gas Limited applied to the Minister of Natural Resources and Forestry for approval to drill three new natural gas injection and withdrawal wells in its Bickford Storage Pool in the township of St. Clair in Lambton County. The Minister of Natural Resources and Forestry referred the application to the Ontario Energy Board. The Ontario Energy Board is required to report to the Minister of Natural Resources and Forestry, before the Minister can issue a licence to drill the wells.

Union Gas Limited has also applied to the Ontario Energy Board for approval to construct 530 metres of 12 inch diameter natural gas pipeline to connect the new wells to Union Gas Limited's system.

A map identifying the location of the proposed wells and pipeline is provided below.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by Union Gas. We will question Union Gas on the case. We will also hear arguments from individuals and from groups that are interested in the case.

As part of its review of this application, the OEB will assess Union Gas' compliance with the OEB's Environmental Guidelines for the Location, Construction and Operation of Hydrocarbon Pipelines and Facilities in Ontario.


The OEB advises Indigenous communities that the OEB's process for this application may serve as a component of the Crown's duty to consult for this project.

 Apply by January 23, 2018 or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
