Notice of Motion to Review and Vary EB-2016-0160 Decision and Order
dated September 28, 2017**

**DECISION ON INTERVENTION REQUESTS
January 15, 2018**

On October 18, 2017 Anwaatin Inc. (Anwaatin) filed with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), a Notice of Motion to Review and Vary portions of OEB EB-2016-0160 Decision and Order in accordance with Rules 40 and 42 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*. The OEB has assigned case number EB-2017-0335 to this proceeding.

The EB-2016-0160 Decision and Order, issued on September 28, 2017¹, determined Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One)'s Transmission Revenue Requirement and Charge Determinants for 2017 and 2018, effective January 1, 2017.

On December 19, 2017, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 for the EB-2017-0335 Motion to Review proceeding. In that Procedural Order, the OEB provided for intervention and cost award eligibility requests from EB-2016-0160 intervenors and for Anwaatin or Hydro One to object to these requests.

The OEB received two intervention and cost award eligibility requests, one from the School Energy Coalition (SEC) and the other from the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC). No objections were filed.

The OEB has considered the intervention and cost award eligibility requests and will grant intervention and costs award eligibility status to both SEC and VECC. A list of participants in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A.
