  - b. the clerk of the Township of Scugog in the Regional Municipality of Durham
  - c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities, including Indigenous communities identified by the Ministry of Energy.
  - d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office,75 Sherbourne St., Suite 222, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
  - e. all affected utilities and railway companies
  - f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- 3. To make a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge Gas' office and in a prominent place on Enbridge Gas' website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, immediately thereafter.
- 5. To provide a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.
