TransCanada PipeLines Limited (TransCanada) Comment on Issues List

TransCanada writes briefly on behalf of the Mainline in response to Procedural Order No. 2, the applicants' proposed issues list, and the intervenors' proposed issues list.

TransCanada is a consumer of transportation service offered by Union and EGD and in the event the application is granted will be a consumer of transportation service offered by Amalco.

TransCanada supports the intervenors' issues list, as its scope includes but is not limited to issues that TransCanada may wish to raise during the proceeding. At this stage, TransCanada's intent is to explore whether post-amalgamation consumers of transportation service of Amalco will be treated on equal footing with one another, including with Amalco, which will consume its own transportation service. TransCanada would seek to raise this issue under any final issues list as determined by the Board.
