We write further to the Ontario Energy Board's Procedural Order No. 3 in this proceeding which directed that any settlement proposal arising from ongoing negotiations be filed with the Board on or before January 31, 2018 and that, if there is no settlement proposal, a statement to that effect was to be filed on or before February 2, 2018.

While settlement discussions have continued since the conclusion of the formal settlement conference held November 2, 2017, the parties have been unable to reach a settlement proposal to submit to the Board.

Union requests that the Board provide Union an opportunity to update its application by February 16, 2018 given the information that has been clarified during settlement discussions and then establish dates for the filing of final written submissions on the outstanding issues identified in the updated application.
