Supplemental Affidavits of Service - Redacted**

On October 12, 2017, the Board issued the Notice of Application and Letter of Direction for the above noted proceeding (“Letter of Direction”).

In December 2017 and January 2018, the construction and access plan was revised based on work undertaken by NextBridge and its new contractor, and input received from regulators and stakeholders as part of the Environmental Assessment process. These revisions included refinements to certain access road, laydown and worker camp locations. As a result of the adjustment twenty-two (22) new properties and interests in land, and corresponding encumbrance holders, were identified as directly affected that were not previously identified (Newly Directly Affected Interests).

Additionally, on November 21, 2017 and January 15, 2018, searches of the Ontario Ministry of Northern Development and Mines (MNDM) disposition registry were conducted to identify newly staked claims impacted by the EWT Line Project footprint. NextBridge’s review of the search identified five (5) newly staked claims that were not previously recorded in the MNDM disposition registry (Newly Staked Claims as at January 15, 2018).

Please find attached the following:

1. an affidavit proving completion of service of the Letter of Direction in relation to the Newly Directly Affected Interests (“Supplemental Affidavit of Service #1”); and
2. an affidavit proving completion of service of the Letter of Direction in relation to Newly Staked Claims as at January 15, 2018 (“Supplemental Affidavit of Service #2”).



In accordance with the Board's revised Practice Direction on Confidential Filings, effective October 28, 2016, Exhibits that contain personal information from the above noted supplemental affidavits of service will be provided to the Board under separate cover.

Enclosed please find the redacted above-referenced supplemental affidavits of service which have been filed through the Board's Regulatory Electronic Submission System.

Given that new claims are regularly staked and recorded in the MNDM disposition registry, NextBridge will continue to periodically search the MNDM disposition registry to identify new claims recorded in relation to lands directly affected by the EWT Line Project footprint. Once new claims are identified and contact information confirmed, claim holders will be served in accordance with the Letter of Direction, and a further supplemental affidavit of service will be provided.
