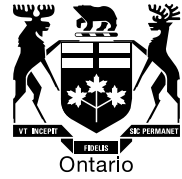

**Re: OM Limited Partnership (OMLP)  
Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Application  
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2017-0289**

On August 24, 2017, OMLP filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity to supply natural gas to a specific address in Langton, Ontario, in the Township of Walsingham, Norfolk County. The application states that, "On-Energy Corp. ("ON") and Maricann Group Inc. ("Maricann") have formed a limited partnership, OM Limited Partnership ("OMLP") for the purposes of supplying the Maricann Langton Facility with local natural gas."

As a result of OEB staff's review of the application, the applicant has indicated that the steps culminating in the formation of OMLP are not yet complete.

Given that OMLP is the purported applicant, the OEB will hold the application in abeyance until the applicant either amends the application to reflect the current corporate structure in place or confirms that the application is accurate as filed.
