Application for a Unit Sub-Metering Licence

Interim Decision and Order

Ensqr Corp. filed an application on February 26, 2018 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) to renew its unit sub-metering licence ES-2012-0461.

The licence that is the subject of the renewal application was issued to the applicant on February 28, 2013 for a five year term and expired on February 27, 2018. The licence provides that the term may be extended by the OEB.

Ensqr Corp. is currently engaged in unit sub-metering activities. As per section 57(c.1) of the OEB Act, no person can engage in unit sub-metering unless licensed to do so. Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need to be licensed to continue with its unit sub-metering activities, it has been found to be in the public interest to issue an interim order granting an extension to the applicant's unit sub-metering licence ES-2012-0461 pending the final disposition of the renewal application.

This Interim Order is being issued by Delegated Authority sections 21(7) and 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application on a timely basis given the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of Ensqr Corp.'s licence ES-2012-0461 is extended until July 31, 2018, or until the final determination of the unit sub-metering licence application, whichever is earlier.
