Review of Customer Service Rules for Electricity and Gas

On May 16, 2017, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) initiated a review of its customer service rules (Rules) for electricity distributors, rate-regulated natural gas distributors and unit sub-meter providers.

As part of its work on the Rules review, by <u>letter</u> dated February 21, 2018, the OEB invited a number of consumer and industry stakeholders to meetings with OEB staff to discuss staff's findings and preliminary proposals for changes to the Rules based on OEB's completed research and engagement activities. The letter stated that the OEB determined the invited consumer representative stakeholders to be eligible for cost awards and that any costs awarded will be recovered from rate-regulated licensed electricity distributors and rate-regulated gas distributors.

A number of consumer representative stakeholders participated in the meetings with OEB staff as follows:

In order to determine the cost awards to eligible participants identified above, the OEB will use the process set out below.

- Eligible participants shall submit their cost claims by April 13, 2018. The cost claim must be filed with the OEB and one copy is to be served, by email, on each rate-regulated licensed electricity distributor and each rate-regulated natural gas distributor. The cost claims must be completed in accordance with section 10 of the OEB's <u>Practice Direction on Cost Awards</u>.
- Rate-regulated licensed electricity distributors and rate-regulated natural gas
 distributors will have until April 23, 2018 to object to any aspect of the costs
 claimed. The objection must be filed with the OEB and one copy must be served,
 by e-mail, on the eligible participant against whose claim the objection is being
 made.
- 3. The eligible participant whose cost claim was objected to will have until **April 30, 2018** to file with the OEB a reply submission as to why its cost claim should be allowed. One copy of the reply submission is to be served, by e-mail, on the objecting party.

The OEB will then issue its decision on cost awards. The OEB's costs may also be addressed in the cost awards decision.
