InnPower Corporation

Application for electricity distribution rates and other charges beginning July 1, 2017

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 9 April 11, 2018

InnPower Corporation (InnPower) filed an amended cost of service application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on May 11, 2017 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B (the Act), seeking approval for changes to the rates that InnPower charges for electricity distribution, to be effective July 1, 2017.

The OEB issued its Decision and Order on March 8, 2018 and set out dates for InnPower to submit its draft rate order, OEB staff and intervenor submissions on the draft rate order, and a reply submission by InnPower.

InnPower filed its draft rate order on March 26, 2018. On April 2, 2018, OEB staff made its submission on the draft rate order, primarily stating that the entire draft rate order needed to be re-filed. No intervenor made a submission. On April 10, 2018, InnPower filed a revised draft rate order.

Given the number of amendments to the draft rate order proposed by OEB staff, the OEB is establishing additional procedural steps for written submissions on the revised draft rate order and for a reply submission by InnPower.

The OEB finds it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- Intervenors and OEB staff may file any comments on the revised draft rate order with the OEB, and forward to InnPower Corporation by April 17, 2018. The OEB intends to allow for an award of costs for the review of the revised draft rate order and filing of comments.
- 2. InnPower Corporation may file with the OEB and forward to intervenors, responses to any comments on the revised draft rate order by **April 23, 2018**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2016-0085, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at https://www.oeb.ca/industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
