**Re: EB-2017-0319: Enbridge Renewable Natural Gas Enabling Program and
Geothermal Energy Service Program**

Pursuant to Procedural Order No. 2 Enbridge is in receipt of interrogatories from intervenors in the above noted proceeding, including from Anwaatin Inc..

Enbridge notes that in Anwaatin's request for intervenor status, counsel for Anwaatin indicated that:

Anwaatin is an Indigenous business corporation that works with Indigenous communities in linked energy markets that include Ontario, Quebec, California and Manitoba. Anwaatin's mission is to ensure that Indigenous communities are front and centre in fighting climate change and leading emerging markets associated with climate change action. Its business focusses on (i) territorial climate change, (ii) readiness for emerging cap-and-trade markets, (iii) strengthening biodiversity and resilience in the face of climate change, and (iv) creating partnerships to sell Indigenous carbon offsets.

The member First Nations communities and organizations participating in Anwaatin in connection with this proceeding will be confirmed in short order.¹

We are not aware of whether Anwaatin has provided the promised confirmation. Enbridge requests that Anwaatin provide its confirmation with respect to the First Nation communities it is representing in this proceeding. If the information has already been filed, Enbridge requests that Anwaatin provide a link to such correspondence.
