Re: Amendment to Schedule 1 of NextEra Energy Canadian Operating Services, Inc. electricity generation licence to add Moore Solar and Sombra Solar generation facilities

NextEra Energy Canadian Operating Services, Inc. (“**NECOSI**”), Moore Solar, LP (“**Moore**”) and Sombra Solar, LP (“**Sombra**”) hereby request that (i) Schedule 1 of NECOSI’s electricity generation licence EG-2012-0311 be amended to add the operation of the Sombra and Moore solar facilities; and (ii) each of Moore and Sombra’s electricity generation licences (EG-2011-0023 and EG-2011-0022, respectively) be amended to delete “operation” of the facilities from Schedule 1.

Details of the above-noted Schedule 1 amendments are set out below.

Name and address of generation facilities and size, fuel type and number of units

Moore facility

This facility is known as St. Clair Solar 1 and St. Clair Solar 2. Each of St. Clair Solar 1 and St. Clair Solar 2 are 10 MW electricity generation facilities using solar energy as renewable fuel. The address of each of St. Clair Solar 1 and St. Clair Solar 2 is Part of Lot 25, Concession 9, and part of Lot 26, Concession 9, Township of Moore, Ontario, as currently set out in EG-2011-0023.

Sombra facility

This facility is known as St. Clair Solar 3 and St. Clair Solar 4. Each of St. Clair Solar 3 and St. Clair Solar 4 are 10 MW electricity generation facilities using solar energy as renewable fuel. The address of each of St. Clair Solar 3 and St. Clair Solar 4 is North half of Lot 1, Concession

10, North half of Lot 1, Concession 11, West half of North half, Township of Sombra, Ontario, as currently set out in EG-2011-0022.

Name of owner and operator

The owner of the Moore facility is Moore Solar, LP. The owner of the Sombra facility is Sombra Solar, LP. The operator of the Moore and Sombra facilities is NECOSI. As noted above, NECOSI is a qualified electricity generation licence holder under licence EG-2012-0311.

Standard offer program contracts

Both Moore and Sombra have RESOP contracts with the IESO.

Details of requested amendments

As noted above, the following amendments are requested:

- amendment of Schedule 1 of NECOSI's electricity generation licence EG-2012-0311 to add operation of the Moore and Sombra facilities; and
- amendment of Schedule 1 of each of Moore and Sombra's electricity generation licences to remove the words "and operation" (EG-2011-0023 and EG-2011-0022, respectively)

There is no change to contact names or addresses in regards to NECOSI, Moore or Sombra.

In addition to the above, Moore and Sombra request that the following typographical error in each of their respective licences be corrected: the first sentence of Section 8.1 currently reads "This licence shall take effect on month day year and expire on month day year." In each of the Moore and Sombra licences, this sentence should read "This licence shall take effect on February 28, 2012 and expire on February 27, 2032."

Request for disposal of amendments without a hearing

NECOSI, Sombra and Moore request that the amendments be processed without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, as no person will be adversely affected by the processing of these amendments.


Request re timing of processing of amendments
