**DECISION AND ORDER**

Ameresco Newmarket Energy Storage Inc. (Ameresco Newmarket) filed an application on April 16, 2018 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity storage licence.

Ameresco Newmarket was set up in 2016 to own and operate the Twinney Drive Newmarket Energy Storage facility, which is expected to be in service in July 2018. The facility has a planned installed capacity of 5 MW and will be operating under a contract with the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO).

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity storage licence to Ameresco Newmarket Energy Storage Inc.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
