## Re: Letters related to the 2018 Cap and Trade Compliance Plan Applications and the OEB's DSM Mid-Term Review

On May 9, 2018 the Environmental Defence submitted a letter to the OEB in relation to the 2018 Cap and Trade Compliance Plan applications.

Within its letter, Environmental Defence requested that the OEB invite Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (Enbridge Gas) and Union Gas Limited (Union Gas) to file plans for incremental conservation measures driven by potential carbon cost savings as part of the OEB's DSM Mid-Term Review.

In the event that the OEB did not invite Enbridge Gas and Union Gas to propose additional conservation opportunities as part of the DSM Mid-Term Review, Environmental Defence requested that the OEB panel hearing the 2018 Compliance Plan applications issue a preliminary ruling on issues associated with incremental abatement.

The OEB subsequently received letters from the Building Owners and Managers Association of Greater Toronto (BOMA), the Vulnerable Energy Consumers' Coalition (VECC), the School Energy Coalition (SEC), the Green Energy Coalition (GEC), Union Gas, the Association of Power Producers of Ontario (APPrO), Enbridge Gas, and Industrial Gas User's Association (IGUA).

The OEB will be discussing the elements of Environmental Defence's letter as part of the upcoming stakeholder meeting on the DSM Mid-Term Review.
