The Corporation of the Town of Collingwood EPCOR Collingwood Distribution Corp.

Applications for approval of share acquisition transactions and related matters

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 June 1, 2018

The Corporation of the Town of Collingwood (Town) and EPCOR Collingwood Distribution Corp. (EPCOR) filed applications on December 27, 2017 under section 86 (2)(b) and section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) (Act).

The Town and EPCOR have requested approval under section 86(2)(b) of the Act for two share purchase transactions that result in EPCOR becoming the new owner of Collus PowerStream Corp. (Collus). The Town will first purchase the shares of Collingwood PowerStream Utility Services Corp. (Collus Holdco), the holding company of Collus, currently owned by Alectra Utilities Corporation. EPCOR will then purchase all of the shares of Collus Holdco from the Town.

EPCOR has also requested approval under section 78 of the Act for a one percent reduction in Collus' 2017 electricity distribution rates for residential customers, to be in effect for five years from the completion of the transactions.

In the Notice of Hearing issued on February 13, 2018, the OEB determined that it will hold a combined public hearing to consider the applications filed. In Procedural Order No. 1 issued on April 4, 2018, the OEB approved SEC as an intervenor and made

provision for interrogatories and interrogatory responses. Interrogatories were filed by OEB staff and SEC on April 19, 2018 and responded to by the applicants on May 3, 2018.

The OEB considers it is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any submissions by OEB staff and SEC or other interested parties shall be filed with the OEB and delivered to the applicants by **June 18, 2018.**
- 2. The applicants shall file any reply submissions with the OEB by June 29, 2018.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file numbers, **EB-2017-0373** and **EB-2017-0374** and be made electronically in searchable/unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
