AFFIDAVIT OF PAUL MALOZEWSKI


I, Paul Malozewski, of the City of Toronto, MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:



ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE

The IESO and Hydro One Networks Inc. have asked the Ontario Energy Board to a review the North American Electric Reliability Corporation Reliability Standard TPL-007-2 - Transmission System Planned Performance for Geomagnetic Disturbance Events

The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) and Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) filed a joint application requesting that the Ontario Energy Board review the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) Reliability Standard TPL-007-2 - Transmission System Planned Performance for Geomagnetic Disturbance Events (the Proposed Standard).

The IESO and Hydro One are also requesting a stay of the operation of the Proposed Standard in Ontario until a NERC process, called a Standard Authorization Request process to develop a variance to the Proposed Standard is complete or the United States' Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issues a ruling on the Proposed Standard, whichever occurs later.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by the IESO and Hydro One. During the hearing, we will question the IESO and Hydro One on its requests. We will also hear questions and arguments from affected persons and groups. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide what, if any, requests will be approved.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review the IESO and Hydro One application on the OEB's website now.
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by June 11, 2018 or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.
