Union Gas Limited has applied for approval of a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the unincorporated/ unsurveyed Kenora District.

Union Gas Limited has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for an order granting Union Gas Limited a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct works to supply natural gas in the unincorporated/unsurveyed Kenora District.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider Union Gas' requests. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide whether to grant Union Gas' requests.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

CERTIFICATES OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

In order to distribute natural gas in Ontario, a person must comply with the requirements of the *Municipal Franchises Act*. This Act requires that a person that intends to distribute natural gas within a municipality must first receive approval from the OEB, in the form of a certificate of public convenience and necessity. Where the OEB has issued a certificate for an area but there is currently no natural gas distribution service, another person can apply for a certificate to serve that area. The OEB also regulates the distribution of natural gas within unincorporated townships and unorganized areas in the same manner.

With respect to the unincorporated/unsurveyed Kenora District, facilities were put in place prior to Union Gas requesting and receiving approval from the OEB in the form of a certificate. This application addresses this situation.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review the application filed by Union Gas on the OEB's website now.
- · You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by June 25, 2018, or the
 hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- · At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

The OEB does not intend to provide for an award of costs for this hearing.

ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD

IN THE MATTER OF the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.55, as amended;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Union Gas Limited for an Order approving a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct works to supply natural gas in the unincorporated / unsurveyed Kenora District.

APPLICATION (Updated)

- 1. Union Gas Limited ("Union"), a regulated public utility, is a corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, with its head office at the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, in the Province of Ontario.
- 2. On August 19, 2016, Union was directed by the Ontario Energy Board to file a report by December 31, 2016 confirming that Union has obtained Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity covering the geographic areas in which its facilities are located. If during its investigation facilities are found to be located in areas where it does not hold Certificate rights, Union is to advise the Board as to where the infrastructure is located and to provide a plan to rectify the situation.
- During its 2016 investigation of Certificates, Union identified a customer being served that was thought to be located within the unincorporated / unsurveyed Kenora District. Upon further investigation, it has been determined that this customer is located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Kenora for which Union holds a franchise agreement (RP-2004-0199 / EB-2004-0402) and a Certificate (RP-2004-0199 / EB-2004-0401 issued September 2, 2004).
- 4. Union has determined that it has facilities in place within the unincorporated / unsurveyed Kenora District from which no end-use customers are provided service. There is no record of a Certificate being issued to Union for the unincorporated / unsurveyed Kenora District.
- 5. Attached hereto and marked as Schedules A(1), A(2) and A(3) are maps showing the location of the unincorporated / unsurveyed Kenora District as well as customer density and metes & bounds descriptions of the area within the unincorporated / unsurveyed Kenora District in which Union has facilities and provides service to an end-use customer. The proposed Certificate area boundary covers an area 66792m x 300m from GPS Coordinates (50.064420, -93.262532) to GPS Coordinates (50.565456, -93.178434) and an area 33245m x 300m from GPS Coordinates (50.821055, -93.409723) to GPS Coordinates (50.931888, -93.766151).

- 6. As is noted above, Union has a franchise agreement with and Certificate for the City of Kenora which is the closest municipality to the unincorporated / unsurveyed Kenora District. Union also has a Franchise Agreement (RP-2000-0075 / EB-2000-0208) with the Township of Ear Falls and a Certificate (EBC 55 issued September 19, 1966) to supply gas to the Griffith Mine at Bruce Lake and within a radius of 16 miles which encompasses the municipal boundaries of the Township of Ear Falls.
- 7. Union is submitting this application for an Order under Section 8 of the *Municipal Franchises Act* based on the assumption that the doctrine of jurisdiction by necessary implication gives the Ontario Energy Board jurisdiction to issue a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in respect of an unincorporated territory.






KENORA DISTRICT (UNSURVEYED) (Buller Township to Ear Falls Township) Legend

(Ear Falls Township to Red Lake Municipality)




