Union Gas is in receipt of a request from Ontario Energy Board staff for clarification regarding Union's applications seeking Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity for unincorporated areas within which Union has facilities as described in the applications.

In the updated applications that were submitted between March 13, 2018 and March 22, 2018, Union indicated that it was seeking approval of Certificates to construct works to supply natural gas in each of the unincorporated areas. The applications went on to identify proposed service area boundaries for each of the requested Certificates which described the areas in which Union has facilities in place.

To be clear, Union is requesting approval of Certificates that cover the proposed service areas as identified by the metes and bounds descriptions and not for the entire unincorporated communities and districts identified in the applications.
