LDC Mergeco will combine the distribution facilities of Thunder Bay Electricity Distribution Inc. (TBH) ED-2002-0529 and Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. (KH) ED- 2003-0030
TBH's distribution facility and electrical system spans, over nearly 387 kilometers of line and is supplied by Hydro One Networks Inc. ("HONI")'s Birch, Fort William and Port Arthur transformer stations. TBH is surrounded by Hydro One, and is not a host utility to embedded distributors. TBH's distribution facilities operate at nominal system voltages of 24.94kV, 12.47kV and 4.16 kV operating voltage. TBH operates 13 substations and has a total supply capacity of approximately 200 MW.
KH's distribution facility and electrical system spans over nearly 88 kilometers of overhead line and 10 km of underground submarine line. KH is supplied through the Hydro One transmission system at 115kV which is stepped down through KH's substation to primary distribution voltage of 12.47kV. KH is surrounded entirely by Hydro One, and is not a host utility to embedded distributors. KH operates with a total supply capacity of approximately 38 MW.

1. Type of Application / 2. Ownership & Operation

This application is being made in conjunction with a "MAADs" application to the OEB under s.86 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, as amended, for the relief necessary to effect the amalgamation of Thunder Bay Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. (OEB Distributor Licence ED-2002-0529), and Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. (OEB Distributor Licence ED-2003-0030) into a single licensed, rate regulated electricity distributor that will serve over 60,000 customers. As part of the MAADs application, the two amalgamating utilities are requesting that the OEB transfer their existing Distributor licences to the new, amalgamated distributor (referred to at the time of filing the MAADs application and the current distribution application as "LDC MergeCo").

To be determined within approximately 60 days of the Ontario Energy Board's Approval of MAAD Application (EB-2018-0124).

LDC Mergeco will consist of the current service areas of Thunder Bay Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. (TBH) ED-2002-0529 and Kenora Hydro Electric Corporation Ltd. (KH) ED- 2003-0030.

Thunder Bay Hydro is a LDC in Northwestern Ontario (1,394 KM from Toronto) which serves approximately 50,700 customers in the City of Thunder Bay and Fort William First Nation Reserve. This Schedule specifies the area in which the Licensee is authorized to distribute and sell electricity in accordance with paragraph 8.1 of Distribution Licensee ED-2002-0529.







LDC Mergeco will continue business activities as it previously had under the former distribution licenses TBH (ED-2002-0529) and KH (2003-0030). LDC Mergeco will continue to distribute and maintain electrical power through both an overhead and underground feeder network to approximately 60,000 customers with employees from the predecessor distributors.

15. Technical Ability:

a) Please describe the applicant's technical ability to carry out the activities applied for including the applicant's specific experience in Ontario and in other jurisdictions.

LDC Mergeco will operate at the same high level of technical ability as its predecessors did previously under their former distribution licenses TBH (ED-2002-0529) and KH (2003-0030). The new amalgamated electricity distribution company will continue to have the required area expertise, experience and the technical ability to carry out electricity distribution activities in its service areas.

A purchasing policy exists which establishes the principles, requirements, accountabilities and guidelines for the purchasing of goods and services. This purchasing policy outlines authorization levels, requirements and approvals necessary to appropriately purchase goods and services from suppliers, vendors and contractors through the use of competitive bids, quotations and awards. The purpose of the applicant's distribution facilities is to provide distribution services to the same areas and customers which were approved under the former distribution licenses TBH (ED-2002-0529) and KH (2003-0030). The predecessor utilities do not serve any wholesale market participants or embedded distributors in either of the former regions and does not plan to as LDC Mergeco.

b) A summary of the business plans relating to the Applicant's proposed distribution business for the next five years. This should include the following:

- a forecast of annual growth in terms of factors such as the amount of electricity distributed (MW and/or MWH), number of customers served, amount of distribution facilities (lines and/or stations), etc.

LDC Mergeco's business plan will be to provide distribution services to the same areas and customers which were approved under the former distribution licenses TBH (ED-2002-0529) and KH (2003-0030). The business plan will be developed to promote economic efficiencies between both geographical regions, and provide benefit to the customers.

Summary of Business Factors:

<u>Forecasted annual growth rate for the applicant:</u> LDC Mergeco does not estimate any significant period of growth in terms of factors such as the amount of electricity distributed in (MW).

<u>Number of Customers Served:</u> LDC Mergeco will service approximately 60,000 customers. The number of customers serviced is not expected to increase largely.

KM of Line: LDC Mergeco does not estimate any significant period of growth in its km of line.

Stations: LDC Mergeco does not estimate increasing stations in the near future.

Attached as Attachment "E" is the pro-forma financial statement which was included in the MAAD Application EB-2018-0124 filed April 6^{T-I} 2018 with the Ontario Energy Board for LDC Mergeco.

c) Estimates of net annual cash flows for subsequent periods to demonstrate financial feasibility and security.

As per the Pro Forma financial statements included in the MADD application, annual cash flows will result in a forecasted cash balance of \$9,34M in 2019.

d) Indication of the Applicant's plans to seek Ontario Energy Board approval for electricity distribution rates.

In this MAADs application (EB-2018-0124), LDC Mergeco has indicated that they will be deferring rebasing for a period of 5 years from the closing of the last proposed transactions. During the rebasing deferral period, LDC Mergeco will be applying for approval of rates in a manner applicable to each of the predecessor distributors.

19. Proposed Business Transactions:

Please provide a brief summary of the expected impact of the proposed business transactions on the Ontario electricity market under the following headings:

a) Facilitate competition and enhance access to transmission/distribution services:

The distribution plan if approved by the OEB in MAAD Application EB-2018-0124 is to provide electricity distribution services as previously approved under the former distribution licenses TBH (ED-2002-0529) and KH (2003-0030). The proposed transaction will have no adverse impact on competition, or the current distribution/ transmission environment.

b) Improve reliability and quality of supply:

Historically the former distribution licenses TBH (ED-2002-0529) and KH (2003-0030) have maintained strong reliability measures in both System Average Interruption Duration Index ("SAIDI") and System Average Interruption Frequency Index ("SAIFI") metrics. Both utilities have expertise in the elements and conditions which affect reliability in Northwestern Ontario and will continue to strive to do so as a new amalgamated utility LDC Mergeco.

c) Promote economic and energy efficiency:

The applicant anticipates that the proposed transaction will promote economic and energy efficiency. The consolidation of two existing distributors will create many opportunities for improved efficiency in the distribution of electricity in the predecessor distributors' service areas, and more opportunities for the promotion of energy efficiency and conservation in those areas. The potential for economic efficiencies and cost effectiveness in the provision of electricity distribution service are why both applicants are proposing to amalgamate resources under one amalgamated Distribution license.
