Comments on Cost Claims

For the above noted proceeding, NextBridge has reviewed the cost claims received from the following parties:

- Batchewana First Nation (BFN)
- Bamkushwada Limited Partnership (BLP)
- Biinjitiwaabik Zaaqing Anishinaabek (BZA)
- Consumers Council of Canada (CCC)
- Métis Nation of Ontario (MNO)
- School Energy Coalition (SEC)
- Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC)

NextBridge makes the following observations following review of the cost claims submitted.

- BLP's claim includes amounts for accommodations which are above the maximum daily rate
 of \$200 and for meals, each of which are no longer allowed as per the Board's letter of
 August 25, 2017 which updated the Board's Practice Direction on Cost Awards; and
- BFN's claim includes amounts related to consultant travel time which is only allowed for
 recovery where work is performed during travel time. Insufficient information is available to
 confirm whether work was completed during the recorded travel time. The BFN claim also
 appears to seek hourly compensation for Chiefs Sayers' time as a consultant as opposed to
 an honorarium claim for participation in the proceeding.



NextBridge has no further comments with respect to the claims and awaits the recommendations and or cost awards of the Board with respect to these cost claims, in consideration of NextBridge's comments.
