## DECISION AND ORDER

Oxy Vinyls Canada Co. (Oxy Vinyls) filed an application on July 9, 2018 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity wholesaler licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant neglected to renew its previous electricity wholesaler licence EW-2011-0300 before it expired on October 23, 2016. The applicant has been operating without a licence since that date, in contravention of section 57 of the OEB Act, and may be subject to an OEB compliance proceeding. In its application, Oxy Vinyls made a commitment to implement internal procedures to ensure such a failure would not happen in the future.

After considering the application, the OEB finds it to be in the public interest to issue the electricity wholesaler licence under Part V of the Act to Oxy Vinyls Canada Co. This licence is granted without prejudice with regard to any future compliance actions.

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
