

# ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE

**OM Limited Partnership has applied for approval of a natural gas rate to supply the Maricann Langton Facility in the Township of North Walsingham, Norfolk County.**

OM Limited Partnership (made up of ON Energy Corp. and Maricann Group Inc.) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for approval of a natural gas rate to supply natural gas to the Maricann Group Inc. Langton Facility, a new greenhouse owned and operated by its affiliate Maricann Group Inc.

OM Limited Partnership is also asking for approval of a price cap incentive rate setting mechanism for the 2019 to 2022 period, exemptions from the Affiliate Relationships Code for Gas Utilities, exemptions from the Gas Distribution Access Rule, and an interim order declaring the proposed rate interim effective September 1, 2018 and until such time that the Ontario Energy Board makes a final determination on the application.

**OMLP has Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct facilities and supply natural gas to the new Maricann Group Inc. Langton Facility.**

## THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by OM Limited Partnership. During the hearing, we will question OM Limited Partnership on its case. We will also hear questions and arguments from parties whose interests may be affected. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide whether to approve the application.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

## BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review OM Limited Partnership's application on the OEB's website now.
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by **September 17, 2018** or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.
