DECISION AND ORDER

DR CHP Inc. and SM CHP Inc. each filed a complete application on June 15, 2018 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act,* 1998 (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence. The licences would allow the applicants to retail electricity to large volume consumers in Ontario.

The applicants will operate the CHP generation facilities installed in multiunit residential buildings and will supply such buildings with electricity generated in accordance with the terms of the Power Purchase Agreements.

The OEB combined the applications into one proceeding, pursuant to section 21(5) of the OEB Act. This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Based on the evidence filed in support of each application and after assessing the conduct, technical capability and financial viability of the applicants, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the applications and issue an electricity retailer licence to each of the applicants.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The application by DR CHP Inc. for an electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
- The application by SM CHP Inc. for an electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
