DECISION AND ORDER

NRStor L.P. 1 (NRStor) filed an application on June 18, 2018 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity storage licence.

NRStor was formed in 2013 to own and operate the Minto flywheel storage facility, located in the Town of Minto, Ontario. The facility has an installed capacity of 2 MW and since 2014 has been providing regulation service to the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) under the authority of an electricity generation¹ licence EG-2013-0315 that is set to expire on November 18, 2018.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity storage licence to NRStor L.P. 1.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
