- d. The Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 311, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
- e. All affected utilities and railway companies
- f. Members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee

(Note: It is acceptable to serve a party with an electronic copy of the evidence provided the party has stated its preference in writing for the same.)

- 3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.'s office and in a prominent place on Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.' website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, immediately thereafter.
