


IN THE MATTER OF the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998

AFFIDAVIT

I, **TIM CURTIS**, of the City of St. Catharines, **MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:**

1. I am the President of Niagara-on-the-Lake Hydro Inc. ("NOTL Hydro").
2. In accordance with paragraph 1(a) of the Letter of Direction dated September 7, 2018, the Notice of Application was served directly on all microFIT customers either by e-mail or, in the case of those who have previously indicated a preference for regular mail, by mail. A copy of the e-mail body and the Notice sent by mail is attached as Appendix 1.
3. In accordance with paragraph 1(a) of the Letter of Direction dated September 7, 2018, the Notice of Application was served directly on all intervenors in NOTL Hydro's 2014 Cost of Service Application EB-2013-0155; namely Energy Probe Research Foundation and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition. A copy of the two e-mails is attached as Appendix 2.
4. In accordance with paragraph 1(b) of the Letter of Direction dated September 7, 2018, the Notice of Application was served directly via e-mail on all 1,642 customers for which NOTL Hydro has an e-mail address and appropriate permission to use such e-mail addresses. A copy of the e-mail body is attached as Appendix 3.
5. In accordance with paragraph 2 of the Letter of Direction dated September 7, 2018, the Notice of Application and a full copy of NOTL Hydro's 2019 rate application are available for public review at NOTL Hydro's office at 8 Henegan Road, Virgil, ON and posted in a prominent place on the website at www.notlhydro.com. A copy of the website and the form of notice in the office is attached as Appendix 4.
6. In accordance with paragraph 3 of the Letter of Direction dated September 7, 2018, the following message was tweeted on September 10, 2018: "We have applied to the @OntEnergyBoard to increase our electricity distribution rates. Learn more. Have your say." A live link to the NOTL Hydro website was provided. A copy of the tweet is attached as Appendix 5.

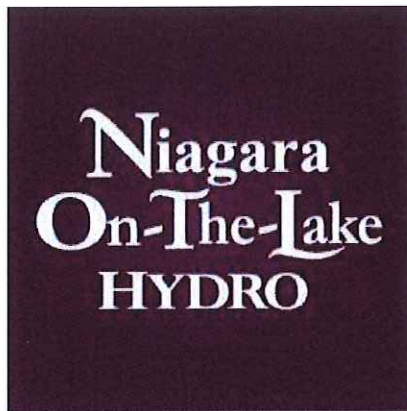

Niagara-on-the-Lake Hydro Inc. has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to raise its electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2019. If the application is approved, a typical residential customer of Niagara-on-the-Lake Hydro Inc. would see an increase of approximately \$1.29 per month. Other customers, including businesses, may also be affected.

Niagara-on-the-Lake Hydro Inc. has also applied for approval of a new standby charge for large business customers with generation, to establish a new Large User class and to increase certain specific service charges and the microFIT service charge. It is important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by these changes.

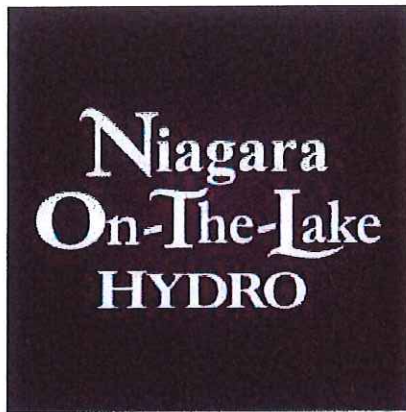

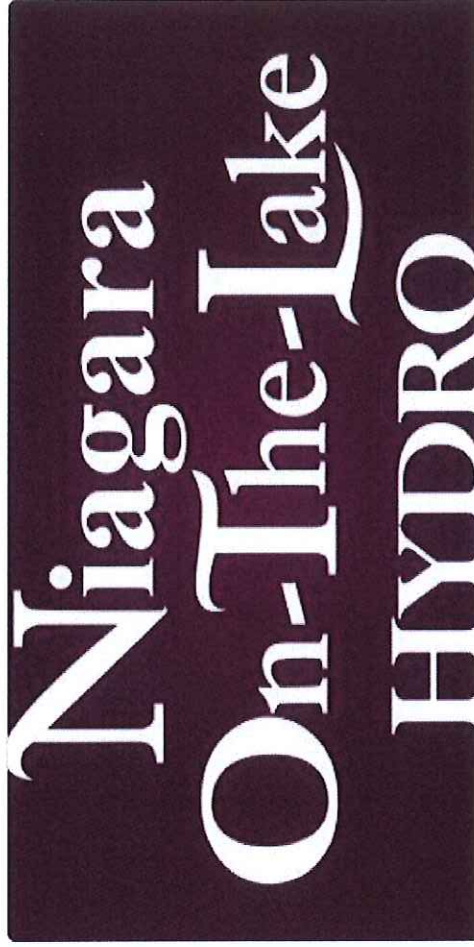
