Union Gas Limited

Application for disposition and recovery of certain 2017 deferral account balances and approval of the earnings sharing amount

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 September 18, 2018

Union Gas Limited (Union) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on June 6, 2018 for approval to dispose of and recover certain 2017 deferral account balances. The total net balance of these deferral accounts is a debit of \$2.2 million.

Union has indicated that its 2017 actual utility earnings did not exceed the threshold established in Union's 2014-2018 Incentive Regulation proceeding¹ and therefore there is no sharing of earnings with ratepayers.

In accordance with Procedural Order No. 1, a settlement conference was held on September 4 and 5, 2018. By letter dated September 12, 2018, Union advised the OEB that there was no settlement proposal resulting from the settlement conference. Union requested that the OEB provide the opportunity for written submissions from intervenors and OEB staff followed by a reply submission.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. OEB staff shall file written submissions with the OEB, and deliver them to Union and intervenors, on or before **October 3, 2018**.
- 2. Intervenors who wish to make written submissions shall file such submissions with the OEB, and deliver them to Union and other intervenors, on or before **October 5, 2018**.

3. If Union wishes to reply to the submissions of other parties, the reply shall be filed with the OEB and delivered to intervenors on or before **October 19, 2018**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2018-0105**, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
