DECISION AND ORDER

HIPCO-Portlands Projects Corporation (HIPCO-Portlands) filed an application on July 17, 2018 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

HIPCO-Portlands was formed in December 2017 to own and operate the Port Lands West CHP generation facility. The facility has a planned installed capacity of 2 MW and will be operating under a CHPSOP contract with the Independent Electricity System Operator.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to HIPCO-Portlands Projects Corporation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
