Re: EB-2018-0243 This letter is to file an objection to proposed rate increases [and one decrease] by OPG to recover, over a three-year period, year-end balances. I am opposed to any increased rates by OPG, even if counter-balanced by a tiny decrease of \$0.21 in 2021. An increase of \$1.39 in 2019 and \$0.06 in 2020 is too much overall, too great of an increase in 2019, and totally unacceptable. With the current rate of inflation, the predicted decrease of \$0.21 in 2021 would be so low, with such a decreased value as to be almost meaningless.
