RE: EB-2018-0243 Application by Ontario Power Generation Inc., Intervenor Request Letter

Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) applies for intervenor status in the EB-2018-0243 proceeding, the application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board for an order or orders to recover the 2017 year-end balances in certain deferral and variance accounts related to its nuclear generating facilities and most of its hydroelectric generating facilities beginning January 1, 2019, and to increase the payment amounts for the output of most of its hydroelectric generating facilities for 2019.

Statement of Interest

Energy Probe is a non-profit environmental and consumer organization which promotes economic efficiency in the use of resources. Energy Probe will be representing its electricity residential customer supporters in Ontario, which we have some number of thousands, and will also be representing a broader concern with respect to the overall financial health and operational integrity of Ontario utilities.
