Métis Nation of Ontario Concerns re Hydro One Interrogatory Responses dated
September 24, 2018**

We are counsel to the Métis Nation of Ontario (“MNO”), an intervenor in the above-noted proceeding.

We adopted NextBridge’s information requests to Hydro One by way of a letter dated August 30, 2018.

On September 24, 2018, Hydro One filed its responses to those information requests. We have now had the opportunity to review Hydro One’s responses, and NextBridge’s letter communicating concerns about those responses dated September 26, 2018.

We have substantially similar concerns to those expressed by NextBridge regarding the extensive confidentiality claims of Hydro One, and the lack of detail provided in its responses. We wish to make the Board aware that we share NextBridge’s concerns as outlined in the September 26 letter.

The MNO’s legal counsel (myself and Jason Madden) have provided signed Declarations and Undertakings to the Board previously, as acknowledged by the Board in Procedural Order 7. As per that Order, we request unredacted copies of all proposed confidential information within the timeline specified by the Board.

Further, we support NextBridge’s request that Hydro One provide complete answers to the requests set out in Table B to NextBridge’s letter.
