This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated September 17, 2018 expressing concern regarding the timeline for obtaining a decision in respect of NextBridge's application for leave to construct the East-West Tie transmission line.

As you are aware, a Procedural Order was issued on August 13, 2018 that makes provision for a combined hearing of that application with Hydro One Networks Inc.'s application for leave to construct the Lake Superior Link and establishes a schedule for the efficient and timely completion of the combined hearing.

Since the case to which you refer is currently a live proceeding, with an assigned panel of Board members, your letter will be placed on the record of the proceeding for consideration by the Board panel.
