As you are aware, the construction of the East-West Tie Line Project (Project) was declared a priority project through the issuance of an Order in Council (OIC 326/2016) that came into effect on March 4, 2016. Within that Order in Council, the description of the Project included an in-service date of 2020.

The Independent Electricity System Operator's most recent Needs Assessment, the "Addendum to the 2017 Updated Assessment for the Need for the East-West Tie Expansion", continues to recommend an in-service date of 2020 for the Project. Although the report indicates that interim measures may be able to address capacity needs until 2022, a delay past 2022 introduces increased risks to system reliability.

In order to avoid delays to the construction of the Project, it is important that the Ontario Energy Board acts expeditiously to issue a decision on the competing Leave to Construct applications for the Project. While I am aware that a combined hearing of both proponents' applications has commenced on October 2, a considerable amount of time has elapsed in order to get to this point. NextBridge filed their Leave to Construct application on July 31, 2017, and Hydro One's application was submitted on February 15, 2018.

While we are aware of the complex circumstances with respect to the competing proposals for this project and the challenges that this presents to the Board, the government would emphasize that this matter should be decided promptly through an efficient and fair process. I am confident that the Board will endeavour to render a prompt decision while of course ensuring that all participants are afforded the opportunity to engage in a full and fair hearing.
