Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.

Application for the disposition of amounts recorded in certain deferral and variance accounts and approval of the earnings sharing amount

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 October 4, 2018

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (Enbridge) filed an application dated June 27, 2018 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, S.O. 1998, c.15, (Schedule B)* for an order approving the disposition of balances in certain deferral and variance accounts. The application also includes a request for approval to share earnings with ratepayers in accordance with the 2014-2018 Custom Incentive Regulation Plan Framework.¹

Enbridge filed a settlement proposal on October 3, 2018, which reflects settlement on a number of issues in the proceeding. Only those issues for which cost award eligibility was granted in the Notice of Application² were addressed at the settlement conference. Enbridge also filed the draft rate order as an attachment to the settlement proposal.

The OEB will provide an opportunity for OEB staff and intervenors to file submissions on the unsettled issues, and for Enbridge to reply. As determined in the Notice of Application, no cost awards for submissions on the unsettled issues will be available to intervenors.

In accordance with Procedural Order No. 1, dated August 10, 2018, OEB staff's submissions on the settlement proposal is due by October 10, 2018.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. OEB staff or intervenors who wish to make written submissions on the unsettled issues shall file such submissions with the OEB, and deliver them to Enbridge and other intervenors, by **October 10, 2018**.
- 2. If Enbridge wishes to reply to the submissions of other parties, the reply shall be filed with the OEB and delivered to intervenors by **October 15, 2018**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2018-0131** and be made electronically in searchable/unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at <u>https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below.
