Dear Minister Phillips and Ontario Energy Board Secretary,

I received a copy of the enclosed letter from Reeve Ed Chambers and the Council of the Township of Dorion, as sent to MECP Special Project Officer Antonia Testa, Environmental Assessment and Permissions Branch. The letter contains formal comments from the Township of Dorion regarding Hydro One's terms of reference regarding their plans for the Lake Superior Link. Also enclosed is a May 20, 2014 Dorion Council resolution declaring that 'no new transmission lines be located by any party within the Township boundaries.'

The letter and resolution have also been copied to Steven Mantifel, Manager, Special Projects, Hydro One. The Dorion concern arises from studies for a new Reference Route Alternative which would enter Township boundaries and affect landowners. Council has deemed previous 'preferred routes' as defined by both Nextbridge and Hydro One as acceptable in the 'Dorion Bypass' section, but assert strong opposition to the 'Route Alternative.'

As MPP for Thunder Bay-Superior North, I will respectfully support Dorion Council's formal comments to the Ministry, and state my support for the related 2014 resolution which ask for planned transmission lines to be routed outside of Township boundaries. I will also respectfully ask that my support as MPP be noted as a formal comment on the Lake Superior Link project by the MECP Environmental Assessment and Permissions Branch, and by the Ontario Energy Board.

Re: Formal Comments from the Township of Dorion regarding Hydro One's Terms of Reference [ToR]

Council has had the opportunity to review Hydro One's Terms of Reference on Hydro One's Lake Superior Link Project website and also the hard copy of the document, which was delivered to the Dorion Township Office.

Following are comments related to our review:

- 1. Dorion Council and a committee appointed by Council, the Dorion Concerned Citizens Committee [DCCC], met several times over the past four years with Nextbridge to agree upon a route [The "Dorion Bypass"] that would have minimal impact on our community, compared to a line parallel to an existing line, which would have a negative impact on our residential and agriculture area.
- 2. We are pleased that Hydro One's preferred route follows the route that the Township and Nextbridge agreed upon.
- 3. We are concerned that the line paralleling the existing line through our community is now being studied as a new Reference Route Alternative. This would negatively affect at least 22 landowners and will put our residents at risk.
- 4. We have attached a 2014 municipal resolution outlining the reasons why we do not want a transmission line going through our community.
- In summary, the Reference Route is acceptable to the affected property owners and the Dorion Council, not only for the present but for the long term; the Reference Route Alternative is not.
