Re: Energy+ Inc. ("Energy+") 2019 Cost of Service Application;
Board File No. EB-2018-0028; Revised Evidence of J. Pollock

We are writing on behalf of Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada Inc. ("**TMMC**") to file revisions to the Written Evidence of Jeffry Pollock to reflect the results of the class cost-of-service study treating TMMC as a separate rate class, as requested by Board Staff in Interrogatory Staff-TMMC-1(b). This study directly and specifically allocates, to TMMC, the costs of all assets used to serve it, including poles, towers and fixtures. This is in contrast to Schedule JP-5 to the Written Evidence of Jeffry Pollock which assumed that the costs of poles, towers and fixtures would be proportional to the ratio of the investments in poles, towers and fixtures to total distribution investment (see Schedule JP-6, page 3). The new class cost-of-service study directly and more accurately allocates these costs to TMMC.

The pages that have been revised are indicated as "2nd Revised" in the page header and the actual revisions are shaded in grey and indicated in the side margin with a side bar.

The revised evidence includes information related to TMMC's consumption of electricity at its Cambridge assembly plant. This information is commercially sensitive and, thus, confidential for the reasons set out in our letter of September 27, 2018. The confidential information has been redacted from the evidence that has been filed through RESS today. In accordance with the Ontario Energy Board's ("**Board**") Practice Direction on Confidential Filings ("**Practice Direction**"), TMMC is delivering to the offices of the Board, a sealed envelope marked "Confidential" that includes: (i) the unredacted, confidential revised pages (printed on green paper) of the Written Evidence of Jeffry Pollock; and (ii) a USB key with the confidential unredacted consolidated evidence, as revised. The confidential revised pages of the unredacted evidence are marked as "Confidential" at the top of each page and the confidential portions of that page are indicated with a yellow highlight. Also enclosed are two hard copies of the redacted, confidential revised pages printed on green paper.

The disclosure of the confidential information in the revised evidence (the "**Confidential Information**") could adversely affect the economic and/or competitive interests of TMMC. Accordingly, TMMC requests that the Confidential Information be held in confidence and not included in the public record of this proceeding. TMMC is prepared to provide unredacted copies of the revised evidence to parties' counsel, external experts, consultants or others who have executed the Board's form of Declaration and Undertaking under the Practice Direction. TMMC reserves the right to object to the Board's acceptance of a Declaration and Undertaking from any person.
